Request:

- 1. How many PCNs have been issued in the last five years for the Town Centre Permit Holders Only areas?? [Such as that in Huntingdon Place]
- 2. How many of these were for a Contravention Code 12??

Response:

North Tyneside currently only retains penalty charge data dating back to 01 January 2014.

In 2014, North Tyneside Council issued 16,087 penalty charge notices for parking and bus lane contraventions across the borough, 5045 of which were for contravention code 12.

In 2015, North Tyneside Council issued 23,265 penalty charge notices for parking and bus lane contraventions across the borough, 5816 of which were for contravention code 12.

In 2016, North Tyneside Council issued 32,841 penalty charge notices for parking and bus lane contraventions across the borough, 6,750 of which were for contravention code 12.

During the period 01 January – 14 November 2017, North Tyneside Council issued 28,068 penalty charge notices for parking and bus lane contraventions across the borough, 5982 of which were for contravention code 12.

In 2014, North Tyneside Council issued 523 penalty charge notices for parking contraventions on Huntingdon Place, Tynemouth, 446 of which were for contravention code 12.

In 2015, North Tyneside Council issued 564 penalty charge notices for parking contraventions on Huntingdon Place, Tynemouth, 470 of which were for contravention code 12.

In 2016, North Tyneside Council issued 508 penalty charge notices for parking contraventions on Huntingdon Place, Tynemouth, 427 of which were for contravention code 12.

During the period 01 January – 14 November 2017, North Tyneside Council issued 386 penalty charge notices for parking contraventions on Huntingdon Place, Tynemouth, 333 of which were for contravention code 12.
