4. Executive summary (taken from written report)

The Authority's Street Lighting Private Finance Initiative (PFI) contract is a joint agreement between the Authority, Newcastle City Council and Tay Valley Lighting (Newcastle and North Tyneside) Limited. It was entered into in 2004 following a European Union compliant competitive procurement process and runs to 2029.

As part of the ongoing work to reduce the electricity consumption of the street lighting portfolio and to help deliver the Authority's Carbon Net-Zero 2030 Action Plan, the Authority is approaching completion of its energy efficient LED lighting retrofit programme.

This report seeks Director of Environment's approval to enter into a Deed of Variation which amends the Street Lighting PFI Project Agreement to reflect the change to LED lighting.
